NICE publishes new guidance on shared decision-making for patients

The National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE) has recently published new [guidance](#) which recommends that shared decision-making is part of everyday practice in all healthcare settings.

Shared decision-making is the term used to describe how health and care practitioners involve patients in making decisions about their care. CNHC supports this approach as it puts patients at the heart of their own care and empowers people to make decisions that are right for them.

This is something that CNHC Registrants are already familiar with and is set out in CNHC's [Code of Conduct, Ethics and Performance](#) (see section B: You must respect clients' rights to be involved in decisions about their care).

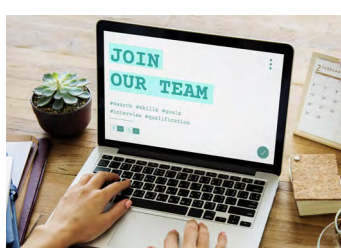
Professor Gillian Leng, NICE chief executive, said: "We're delighted to see this shared decision-making guideline published and we hope it will help people using healthcare services feel more confident in discussing care and treatment options with their healthcare teams.

Siân Phipps, a lay member of the guideline committee, said in a [blog piece](#): "Empowerment – choice – trust – respect – ownership – confidence – equality: this is the language of shared decision making. It's about identifying 'what matters to you', not 'what's the matter with you?'"
