

**CNHC's position on registration for students who have successfully completed
CIBTAC
Aromatherapy, Massage Therapy or Reflexology courses**

1. From 2012/13 academic year

Students who successfully complete a CIBTAC Level 3 Diploma in Aromatherapy, Massage therapy or Reflexology will be eligible to apply to register with CNHC on the basis of this qualification alone, because they meet the National Occupational Standards plus core curriculum for their discipline. Relevant course titles are outlined below.

Qualifications which meet CNHC's entry criteria:

CIBTAC Level 3 Diploma in Aromatherapy – (QCF) 600/5658/7

CIBTAC Level 3 Diploma in Reflexology – (QCF) 600/5657/5

CIBTAC Level 3 Diploma in Massage – (QCF) 600/5671/X

2. 2011/12 academic years

• Level 3 Diploma (7-unit courses)

Students who have successfully completed a CIBTAC Level 3 Diploma in Aromatherapy, Massage therapy or Reflexology (7-unit course) in the 2011/12 academic year are eligible to apply for CNHC registration without any additional training, because they meet the National Occupational Standards and core curriculum for their discipline.

Qualifications which meet CNHC's entry criteria:

CIBTAC Diploma in Aromatherapy 600/3627/8

CIBTAC Diploma in Reflexology 600/3673/4

CIBTAC Diploma in Massage 600/3675/8

3. Qualifications obtained prior to 2010/11 academic year

Students who have successfully completed a CIBTAC Level 3 Diploma in Complementary Therapies below, from September 2009 to January 2011 are eligible to apply for CNHC registration without any additional training, because they meet the National Occupational Standards and core curriculum for their discipline

CIBTAC Qualification which meets CNHC's requirements prior to 2010/11

CIBTAC Level 3 Diploma in Complementary Therapies (QCF) 500/4748/6

Students who have completed CIBTAC qualifications in aromatherapy, massage therapy, reflexology or complementary therapies other than those listed above are of course, eligible to apply to register with CNHC and should be encouraged to apply. Depending on the qualifications undertaken they may need to provide additional evidence to the relevant CNHC verifying organisation about how their knowledge, skills and experience meet both the National Occupational Standards and core curriculum for the relevant discipline. This may involve supplying details of CPD and other relevant experience, in addition to any relevant qualifications obtained.
