A rare and exciting opportunity has arisen for a lead complementary therapist to join our vibrant team at Enable substance misuse service and make a real difference to some of the most vulnerable and challenged members of our community.

Enable is run in partnership with The North London Mental Health NHS Partnership & Humankind charity. The team operates from 2 sites in Enfield to provide a wide range of substance misuse services to local residents including, substitute prescribing, community detox, criminal justice interventions, community care assessments, psycho-social groups, complementary and primary health care as well as a wide range of other interventions to non-opiate and alcohol users.

Humankind is seeking to recruit a new complementary therapy co-ordinator who has the professionalism, dynamism and organisational skills to continue to drive forwards this valuable part of our service. You will be an experienced practitioner in at least one modality, be passionate about reducing health inequalities and have empathy for those with mental health needs.

Your role will involve the management of the complementary therapy team, who at this time comprise of 7 volunteer practitioners who provide a range of interventions, including: massage, reflexology, craniosacral therapy, acupuncture, and yoga. You will be actively involved in the provision of therapeutic sessions, manage the diary, publicise and review services, process referrals, liaise with staff, service users and volunteers. You will work in conjunction with the Volunteer co-ordinator for London and South to recruit and induct new volunteer practitioners and offer them continued supervision and support to practise in an enriching and safe environment.
