

Registration with the CNHC for Alexander Technique teaching

In order to be eligible to apply for registration with CNHC practitioners must have

 undertaken a programme of training that meets, as a minimum, the Alexander Technique National Occupational Standards and the <u>Alexander Technique Core</u> <u>Curriculum</u>. The minimum level of qualification required is equivalent to 5 (England and Wales); 6 (Northern Ireland); 8 (Scotland) on the <u>UK Qualification Comparison</u> <u>Chart</u>

OR

 have achieved competence to the level of the Alexander Technique National Occupational Standards by means of relevant experience of at least three years and been assessed as having met those Standards.

Please note, courses delivered entirely by distance learning do not meet CNHC requirements.
